Topic of the Conference

The **illicit trade in cultural property threatens global heritage and security**, particularly in conflict zones where weak institutions enable looting and trafficking, often funding criminal or terrorist groups. International legal frameworks remain inadequate, highlighting the **vital role of diplomacy**, **youth engagement**, and **mediation** in protecting and recovering cultural assets.

Italy leads global efforts through **pioneering initiatives** like the Carabinieri TPC and the "Blue Helmets of Culture," which serve as models in heritage protection.

To advance these efforts, the **Heritage International Institute** and the **Carabinieri Arm Corps**, with the support of **Regione Lazio**, present the **international conference** "The Fight Against **Illicit Trafficking of Cultural Objects through Diplomacy, Law, Technologies, and the Carabinieri's Role.**"
